Invitation for proposals for changes to the IAG Statutes and Bylaws

Article 16 of IAG's Statutes specifies that the Association shall review its Statutes and Bylaws to ensure an upto-date structure of its scientific organization every eight years. The last time such a review was initiated was about eight years ago under the presidency of Gerard Beutler. It is now therefore time that we again take a fresh look at our Statutes and Bylaws. To achieve this goal, a Review Committee (traditionally called the Cassinis Committee) was appointed in the fall of 2011 by the IAG Executive. The committee is chaired by Michael Sideris and includes as members Harald Schuh, Ruth Neilan and Yoichi Fukuda. A proposal with all suggested revisions will be made by the Cassinis Committee for consideration by the IAG Executive and possibly the Council at the 2013 Scientific Assembly. In this way, we are hoping to get the Council's reaction and input to the proposed changes before these are finalized and approved at the next IUGG General Assembly in 2015.

With this announcement, the Cassinis Committee is inviting proposals for changes of any article of the Statutes and Bylaws. Proposals can be submitted through the IAG website Forum (<u>www.iag-aig.org/proposals</u>). The actual Statutes and By-laws can be found on the IAG website. All proposals submitted **between March 1**, **2012 and February 1**, **2013** will be considered by the Cassinis Committee.

The VIII Hotine-Marussi Symposium

Dear Colleagues and Friends,

It is both our privilege and pleasure to invite you to the *VIII Hotine-Marussi Symposium*, which will be held at the *Faculty of Engineering of the University of Rome "La Sapienza"*, *Italy on June 17-21, 2013*, under the scientific coordination of the <u>Intercommission Committee on Theory (ICCT)</u> of the International Association of Geodesy (IAG).

This First Circular just brings some general information; more details will be available soon at the <u>Hotine-Marussi Symposium 2013</u> website.

Objectives

The main goals of the Symposium are aligned with the objectives of the ICCT:

- advances in theoretical geodesy
- developments in geodetic modelling and data processing in the light of the recent advances of the geodetic observing systems
- connections and contribution exchanges between geodesy and other Earth sciences

In particular, *all the topics regarding the activities of the* **<u>ICCT Study Groups</u>** *are of interest* and related papers are strongly encouraged.

Further, also papers concerning other topics related to the possible interaction and mutual benefits between geodetic theory and methodology and other initiatives/projects involving Earth sciences (for example the <u>Group</u> on Earth Observation) are welcome.

In this respect, it has also to be recalled that 2013 will be the special year for the Mathematics of Planet Earth.

Venue

The Symposium will be held at the Faculty of Engineering of the Sapienza University of Rome, Italy, in the ancient chiostro of the Basilica of S. Pietro in Vincoli, where the worldwide known Michelangelo's statue *Moses* is placed. The Symposium location is downtown Rome, at walking distance from the Colosseo, Fori Imperiali and many other famous archaeological sites and monuments.

Please, mind that June is a high-season tourist period in Rome, so that *an early registration and accomodation booking is highly recommended*.

Abstracts, presentations and papers

Abstracts should be prepared according to guidelines and submitted through e-mail.

Deadline for submission is February 28, 2013. Both the guidelines and the e-mail address are available on the Hotine-Marussi Symposium 2013 website.

Each abstract will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee and its eventual *acceptance will be notified by e-mail* to the Corresponding Author by March 31, 2013.

Upon abstract submission, the Corresponding Author will need to indicate *the preference for oral or poster presentation*. However, the final decision for the presentation form will be taken by the Scientific Committee during the abstract review.

Guidelines for *full paper* submission for peer-review and related formatting instruction will be available through the <u>Hotine-Marussi Symposium 2013</u> website.

Accepted papers will be published by Springer as a volume of the official IAG series.

Registration fees

Two kinds of registration fees are distinguished:

- regular registration: 450 Euro
- student registration: 250 Euro (confirmation of student status by supervisor required)

An additional 100 Euro fee will be charged for late registration (after April 15, 2013).
