IAG on the Internet



The maintenance of the IAG website is one of the activities of the Communication and Outreach Branch (COB), hosted by the Department of Geodesy and Surveying of the Budapest University of Technology and Economics, Budapest, Hungary. The geographical distribution of the visitors to the IAG website can be seen in the Figure, for the period September 2015 to January 2016.

During the past four years, the layout of the website has been redesigned. For example, the Topic of the Month section on the home page aims to promote important scientific activities to a general readership. The latest scientific results, the establishment of significant research projects, and news of important initiatives which may have a great impact on the geodetic and geosciences communities are posted to this section of the website.
